## No Cook Cinnamon Applesauce Ornament Recipe

This recipe makes a large batch of cinnamon applesauce ornaments, enough for approximately 10 ornaments. For larger or smaller groups of children, adjust the recipe accordingly.

## **Supplies**

- wax paper
- rolling pin
- cookie cutters
- drinking straw
- spoon for stirring
- bowl

## Ingredients

- 3 cups applesauce
- 5 cups ground cinnamon
- 1 cup Elmer's white liquid glue

## **Directions**

- First, mix the applesauce, cinnamon, and glue together in a bowl until it is thick enough to hold a form when cut into shapes with a cookie cutter.
- Spoon the dough onto a sheet of waxed paper and cover it with another sheet.
- Now, roll the dough with a rolling pin between two pieces of wax paper until it is approximately 1/4 inch thick or more. If your dough is rolled too thin it may break when dry.
- Next, use cookie cutters in the dough to create shapes.
- Leave the shapes on the waxed paper to dry for approximately 24-48 hours depending on the size and thickness of the cookies.
- If you would like to hang your ornament on a tree, make a hole in the dough with a straw before drying.
