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Sequence Sheet Directions

Objective:

✓ Learners will cut out picture cards and glue them in the correct order.

Materials:

- ✓ Regular Copy Paper
- ✓ Printer
- √ Scissors
- ✓ Glue Sticks
- ✓ Optional: Crayons

Directions:

Print the black and white or color sequence sheet, one sheet per student.

Next, review the sequence with your students in your small group.

Then, demonstrate cutting and gluing the pictures in order on the sheet.


Last, invite your students to color, cut, and glue their own pictures in order on their sheets.

You can also have your students color the pictures with crayons first, before cutting and gluing.

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




Sequence Card Directions

Objective:

✓ Learners will use picture cards to demonstrate a sequence of events.

Materials:

- ✓ Cardstock, Regular Copy Paper, or AstroBrights Paper
- ✓ Printer
- ✓ Laminating Film
- ✓ Scissors

Directions:

Print the pages of your choice on the paper of your choice. You may wish to laminate the sequencing cards for durability and re-use.


Next, introduce the sequence in large or small group using the cards. Say something like, "Today we're going to learn all about how to ______ before?"


Then, demonstrate putting the cards in order using a pocket chart or a magnetic or Velcro surface.


Last, invite students up individually to "help" you place the cards in order again.


You can place the sequencing cards in a pocket chart for independent practice along with some fun pointers..

Sequence Booklet Directions

Objective:

✓ Learners will retell the sequence of events using a folded booklet as a prompt.

Materials:

- ✓ Regular Copy Paper or AstroBrights Paper
- ✓ Printer
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Optional: Crayons

Directions:



Print one booklet for each child in your small group. There are black and white or color versions for you to choose from.

Next, fold each booklet twice, once on the horizontal line and once on the vertical line to create a booklet.

Then, demonstrate using the booklet to retell the sequence of events.

Last, invite students to retell the sequence of events on their own using the booklet as a prompt.

You can also invite your students to color their black and white booklets if you wish.
