
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


















Feed the Unicorn Rhyming Activity

Objective:

☐ Students will practice identifying words that rhyme

Skills Addressed:

✓ Phonological Awareness - Rhyming

Setting:

- ☐ Small Group
- ☐ Literacy Centers

Materials to Gather

- ☐ Tissue box, paper bag, or container
- □ Cardstock
- □ Scissors
- ☐ Tape or glue
- ☐ Laminating Film & Laminator



Feed the Unicorn Directions

Prep for Play

- STEP I: Print and laminate the Feed the Unicorn rhyming cards and the unicorn's face.
- STEP 2: Cut out the face with scissors.
- STEP 3: Cut out the mouth on the unicorn's face and attach it to a tissue box, paper bag, or container with glue or tape.
- STEP 4: Cut out the rhyming cards.

How to Play

STEP I: Place the tissue box, bag, or container with the unicorn's face on the table, facing the students.

STEP 2: Place the rhyming cards on a flat surface easily accessible to all students in your small group.

STEP 3: Demonstrate how to play the game by selecting a card, saying the words on the card, and determining if the rhyme.

STEP 4: If the images on the card rhyme, students can "feed" it to the unicorn by placing it in the unicorn's mouth.




Rhyming Answer Key




