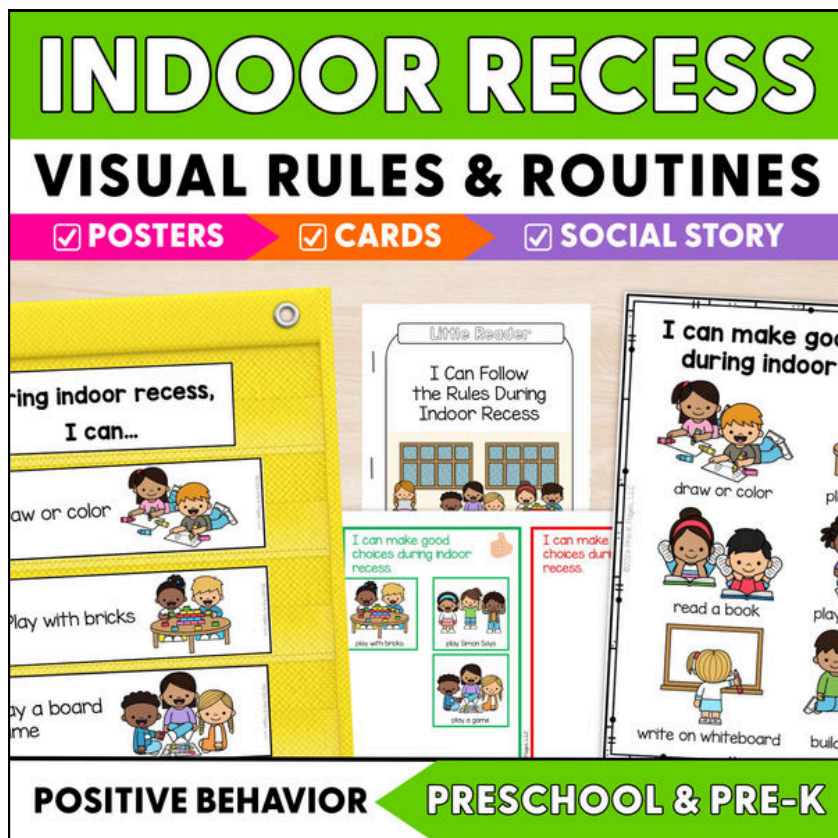


INDOOR RECESS CHAOS?

WHY INDOOR RECESS FEELS SO HARD

Indoor recess isn't "just play."

It requires clear structure – especially in early childhood.

INDOOR RECESS RULES

From Indoor Recess Chaos
To Calm, Structured Play

No More:

- ✗ Arguing
- ✗ Running Around
- ✗ Hitting (or worse)
- ✗ Yelling & Shouting



SIMPLE LANGUAGE • KID-FRIENDLY VISUALS

Indoor recess can be chaotic

- 👎 Running indoors
- 👎 Loud voices
- 👎 Constant redirecting
- 👎 Students unsure of expectations

Explicitly teaching the routine will help improve unsafe behaviors

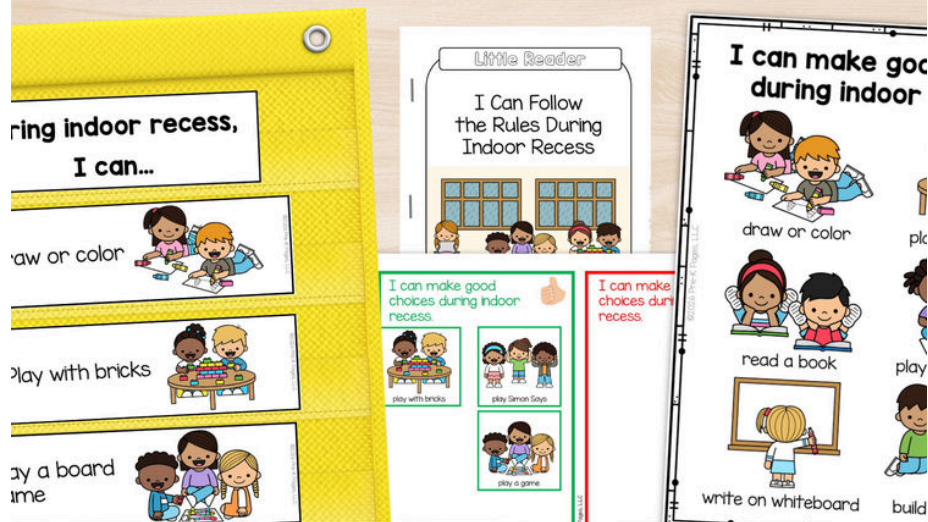

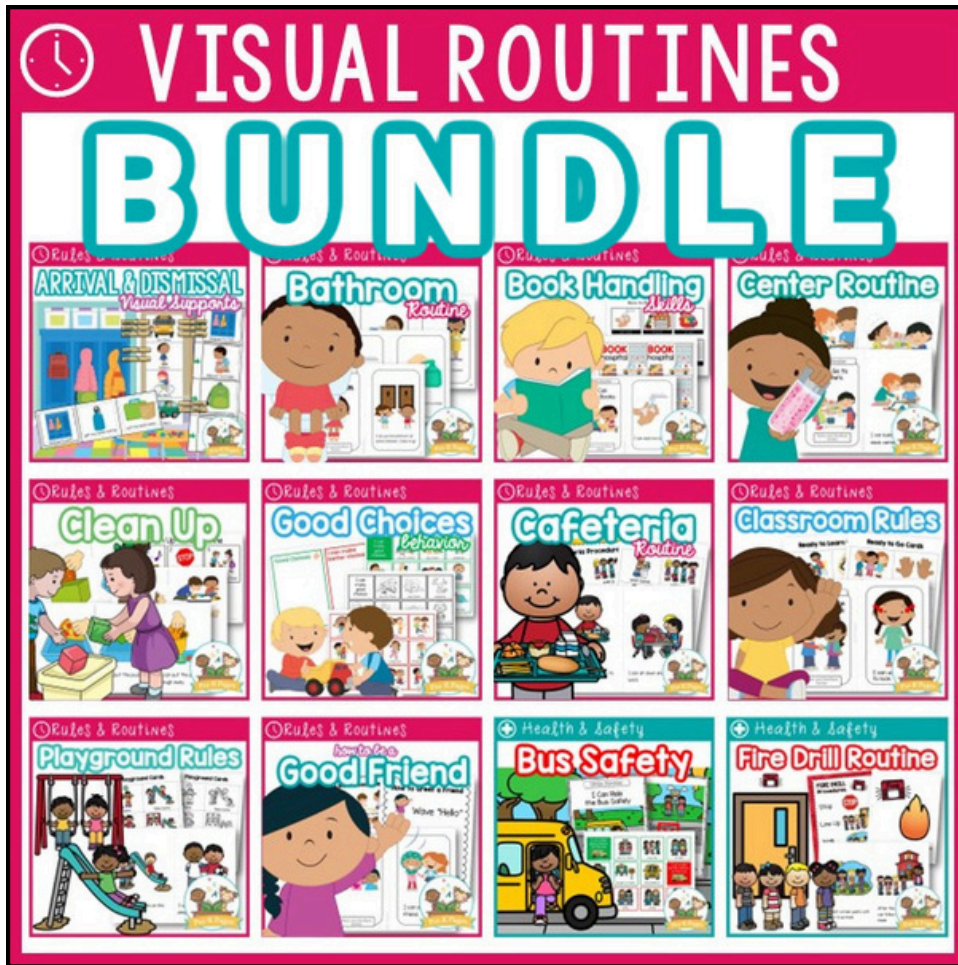
