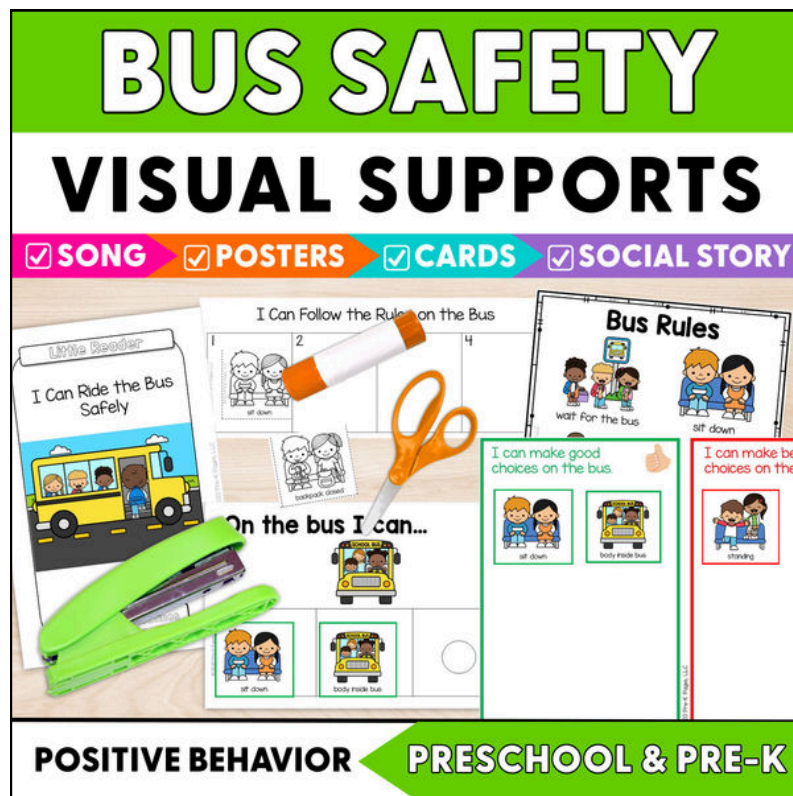

BUS SAFETY VISUAL ROUTINE

RIDING THE BUS IS DIFFICULT FOR PRESCHOOLERS

Without clear routines, children don't know how to ride the bus safely.

BUS TIME = UNSAFE BEHAVIORS

Visuals make expectations clear
Supports calm, safe bus routines

No More:

- Running Around
- Yelling
- Hitting (or worse)
- Angry Parents
- Angry Bus Drivers



SIMPLE LANGUAGE • KID-FRIENDLY VISUALS

Teachers often hear reports of children who are:

-  Walking in the aisles
-  Standing up
-  Yelling
-  Hitting (or worse)

Explicitly teaching the routine will help improve unsafe behaviors

BUS SAFETY VISUAL ROUTINE

WHY VISUAL BUS RULES WORK

When children are explicitly taught the expectations for riding the bus, their unsafe behaviors will decrease.

SIMPLE LANGUAGE • KID-FRIENDLY VISUALS

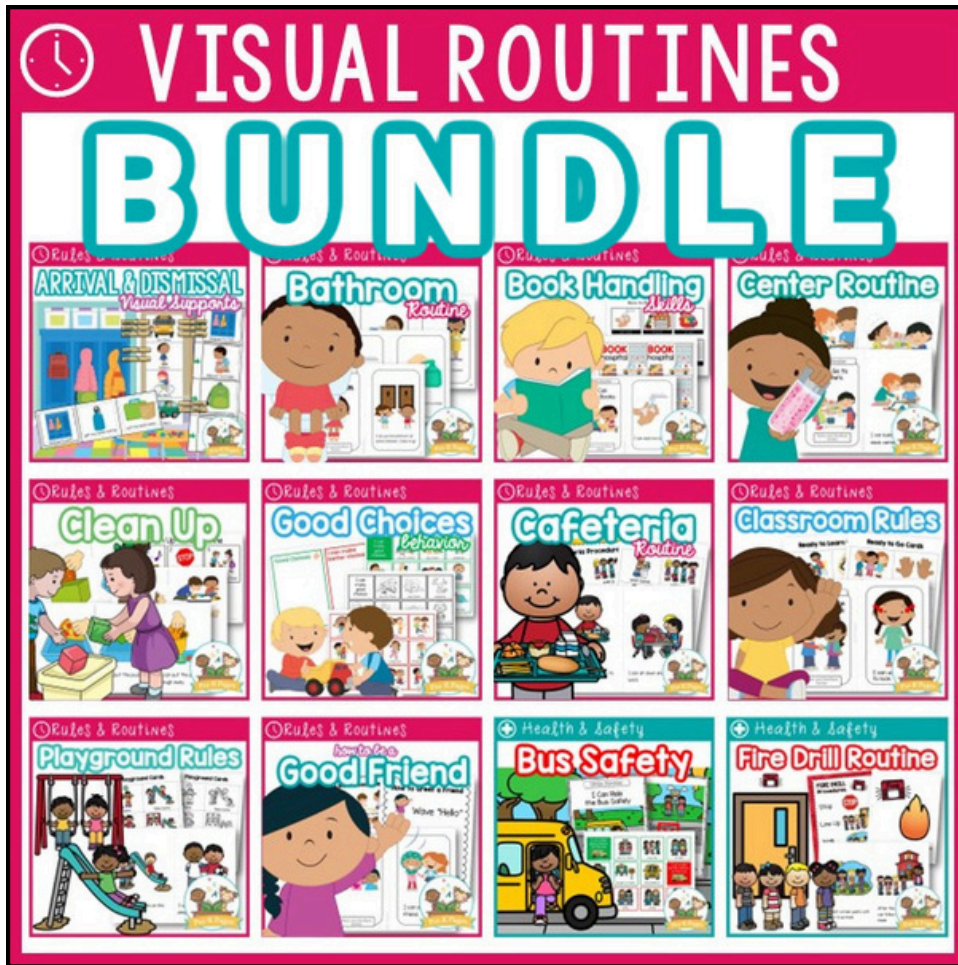
These visuals give kids:
